

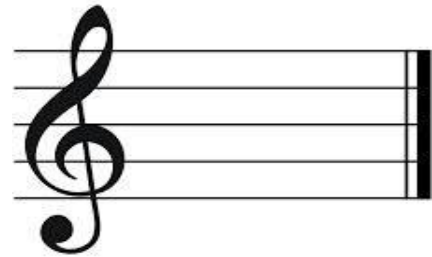
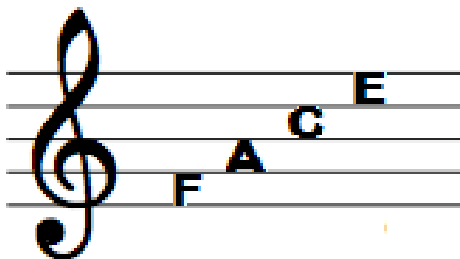

Each staff should start with the treble clef*:














Do - C Re - D Mi - E Fa - F Sol - G La - A Ti - B

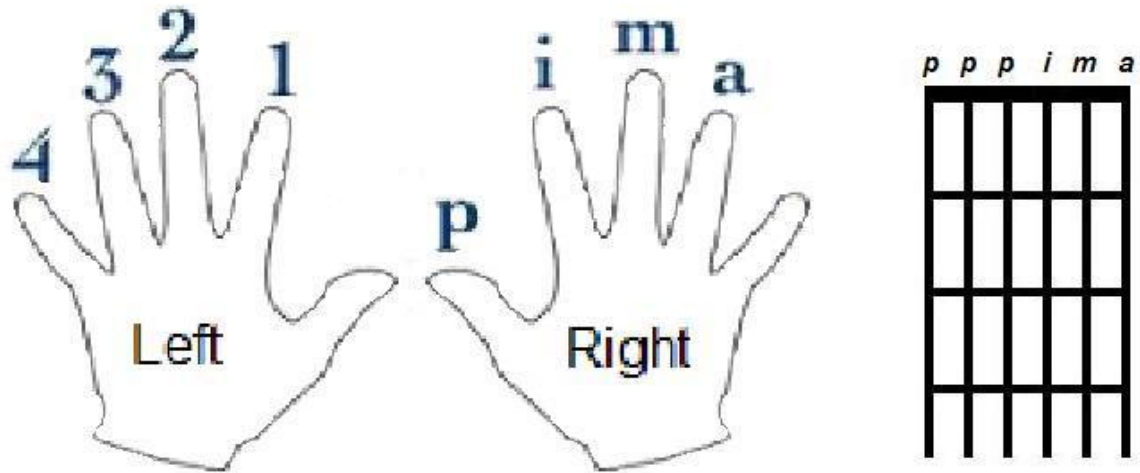

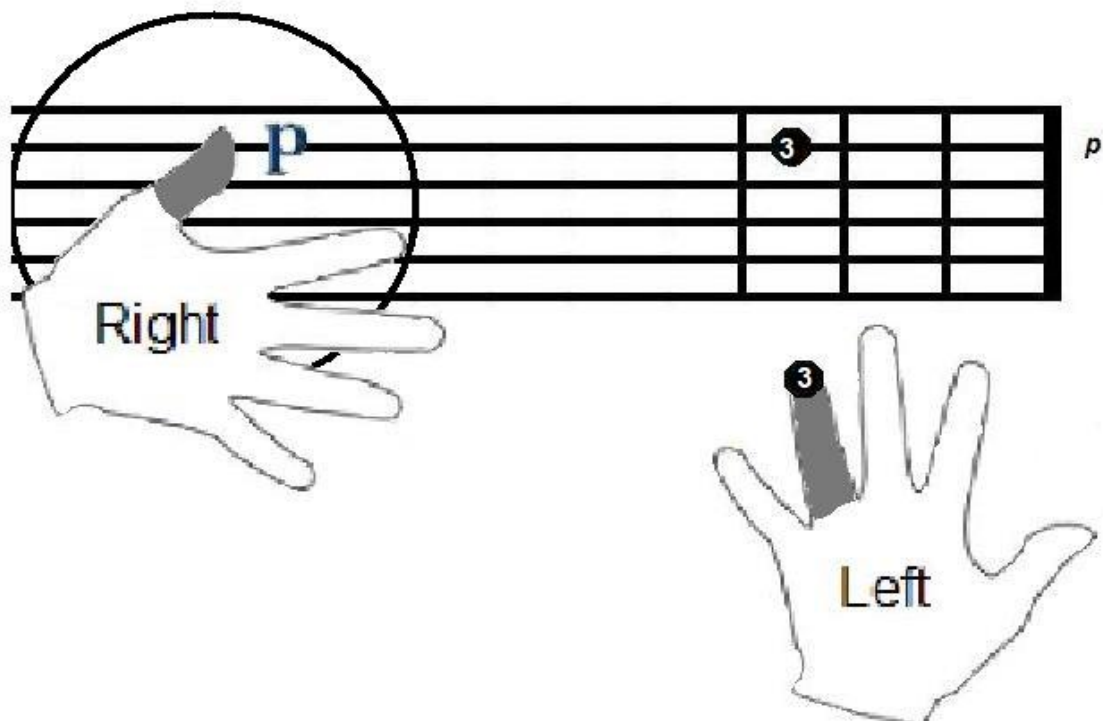
	Name	Note	Rest	
1 is for	Whole Note			is worth 4 beats
2 is for	Half Note			is worth 2 beats
4 is for	Quarter Note			is worth 1 beat
8 is for	Eighth Note			is worth 1/2 beat
16 is for	Sixteenth Note			is worth 1/4 beat

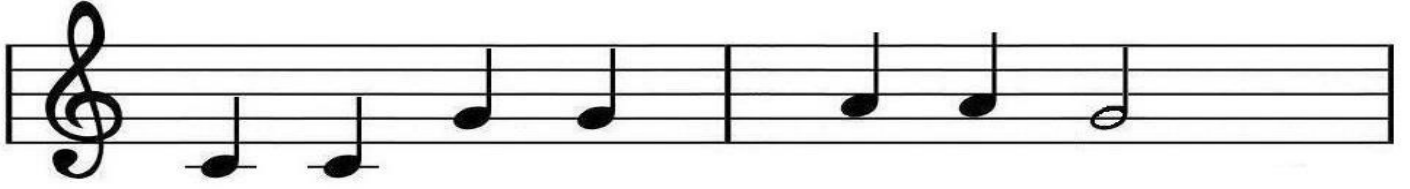

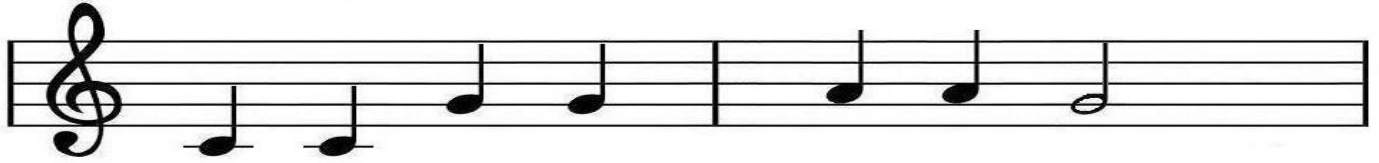

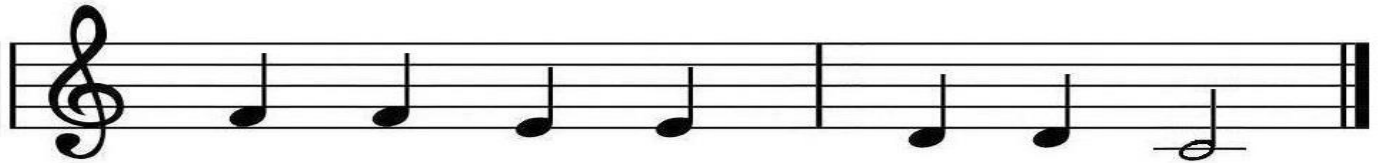
